

This plan will be used for meal service. It was written by Mike Smith.

The following plan will be used for BREAKFAST each day of camp:

Counselors and campers will meet in their cohort room in the morning. Breakfast will be available for pickup in the great room in Clark. After a satisfactory temperature check and symptom screening, one counselor will pick up the box of food for the cohort. All counselors and campers will have temperature and symptom checks before breakfast. Campers will eat breakfast in their cohort room. All other adults will have breakfast in the great room in Clark. All adults will have temperature and symptom checks before breakfast. All adults must wear masks for breakfast unless they are seated at a table.

The following plan will be used for LUNCH and SUPPER each day of camp:

The three camper cohorts with their counselors will be seated in the inside dining hall area, each with their own assigned table for the entirety of camp. The patio area will be used for the adult cohorts and staff. The tables for each cohort will be at least 10 feet away from tables for other cohorts. A maximum of 50 people can be seated in the indoor dining hall at one time. Camper cohorts will enter and exit through the double doors in the main dining hall. Adult cohorts will enter through the door on the patio and exit through the double doors in the main dining hall or the door to the patio. There will be no tables between the main pillars in the dining hall so we have a large entrance/exit pathway.

Cohorts will be held at the top of the stairs leading down to the dining hall. Masks will be required around Fell and in the dining hall area unless seated at your cohort table. One cohort at a time will be released to go into the dining hall to get food. Once they are in the dining hall, a second cohort will be released to the entrance door. The next cohort can enter the dining hall once the cohort before them is seated at their table. This process will repeat until all campers and adults are seated.

To minimize potential transmission, cohort order of service, entrance, and exit should be as follows:

1. Adult cohort 1 (directors, volunteers)
2. Camper cohort 1 - to be seated in the hallway area between the partial wall and outside wall next to patio
3. Camper cohort 2 - to be seated against the fireplace wall
4. Camper cohort 3 - to be seated at the middle tables
5. Adult cohort 2 (band, speaker)

No two cohorts can be up and moving at the same time. I.e., one cohort can't be leaving if another is being served.

Per conversation with QRC staff:

1. Plexiglass is being installed around the service line. Campers will accept their plate at the end of the service line as usual.

2. Condiments will stay on tables for cohort use, as long as they are sealable. Condiments with openings (such as salt and pepper shakers) will be up at the service line and available upon request. Those who request must be wearing a mask and hand sanitize prior to touching shared items.
3. Coffee bar will not be accessible during meals due to shared items.
4. Beverage carafes will be at each table for drinks.
5. QRC staff will clean and sanitize after each meal.
